

MEMBER AREA RESIDENTIAL CUSTOMER POLICY

Member Area: Pulaski County, Town of Dublin, City of Radford, Giles County, and Montgomery Regional Solid Waste Authority (MRSWA)

All construction debris to include but not limited to siding, roofing, and flooring materials received from Pulaski County, Town of Dublin, City of Radford, and Giles County **must** be accompanied with a properly completed disposal permit issued by the local building official or Radford University. The original disposal permit with any required testing documentation must be provided to NRRRA prior to disposal of the material. NRRRA will maintain the original (white copy) for record and require the hauler to maintain the copies (pink and yellow) to accompany each load. Each load will be paid by customer at the time of disposal. The disposal permit forms are supplied to the Member Area representatives by NRRRA. The disposal permits are used to ensure waste to be disposed meets the disposal criteria per Permit Number 548 to include, but not limited to, waste criteria and generator location. If the waste material has been deemed acceptable non-friable asbestos and the demolition process has not altered the material so that it is no longer acceptable, the NRRRA should be notified in advance with the appropriate documentation and at the scale house upon delivery so that special care can be taken to provide the best practical protection to all the customers and staff. NRRRA access no cost to the customer for issuance of disposal permits.

Customers from MRSWA member area are not permitted to direct haul to NRRRA without permission from the Executive Director's of both Authorities. NRRRA will not be responsible for billing MRSWA member area customers, except for the VPI coal ash received for alternate daily cover. All other waste material from MRSWA member area will be charged to MRSWA.

Residential customers from Giles County and the City of Radford are required to pay for each load at the time of disposal. If waste material is hauled by a passenger vehicle or light truck (to include trailers) not registered in Giles County or City of Radford, customer will be required to provide a Giles County or City of Radford address and sign the scale ticket.

All disposal fees for residential customers that are driving a vehicle with a decal from Pulaski County, the Town of Dublin, or the Town of Pulaski will be charged to the Pulaski County Public Service Authority (PSA), Town of Dublin, or Town of Pulaski, the customer will be required to provide a valid address from one of these areas and sign the scale ticket, and then the disposal fees will be charged to the respective jurisdiction.

Floyd County is a customer not a Member; residential customers from Floyd County are not permitted to dispose of waste at NRRRA.
